1 (Whereupon, the following proceedings were had in the
2 presence of the jury.)

3 THE COURT: Mr. Webb, you may proceed with your
4 questions.

5 MR. WEBB: Thank you, Judge.

6 BY MR. WEBB:

7 Q Good morning, Ms. Combs. Have you ever been to Ron
8 Weinland's home here in Kentucky?

9 A Yes.

10 Q Could you please describe it for the jury?

11 A Just an average home. I've got a lot of friends who have
12 basically the same type. Kind of ranch style and has a finished
13 basement, which has got offices in it.

14 Q Have you ever seen any church work being done in the
15 basement?

16 A Yes, I've participated in that.

17 Q Could you describe that for the jury?

18 A When the book started, the orders started coming in for it,
19 we would have work parties, sometimes up to 40, 50 people, and
20 we would -- some people would put the books in envelopes, some
21 would put stamps, some would put address label. We had a couple
22 of binders, we would bind the book. Then we had some people
23 that took the books to the Post Office.

24 Q Thank you, ma'am. Were there any machines involved in the
25 book processing that you recall?

1 A Binders.

2 Q Binders. Could you describe the binding machines for the
3 jury?

4 A It's just a machine that you put maybe ten books in there
5 and it puts a plastic strip that's tight around it. It keeps
6 the books from moving and keeps them in place.

7 Q Thank you. I want to switch gears just a moment. Do you
8 and other church members ever get together for church meals or
9 dinners?

10 A Yes.

11 Q Has the church or Ron Weinland ever paid for those meals?

12 A From 2004 to 2008?

13 Q Yes.

14 A Not to my knowledge.

15 Q How about any other times?

16 A Are you talking about present? I haven't been -- there
17 have been elders' meetings. There have been elders' meetings
18 where the meals have been paid for.

19 MR. WEBB: Thank you, ma'am.
